Board Action at Public Meetings



- Properly Called Public Meeting
- Quorum Present
- Public Discussion and Dialogue
- Public Votes
- Majority Approval
- Accurate Minutes

- Purposes of Public Meetings Law:
 - To open meetings of governing bodies to the public;
 - To give notice of the time and place of meetings; and
 - To make meetings accessible to those wishing to attend.
 - No requirement to let the public talk.
 - "Public meeting" and/or "Public hearing."

Running an effective board meeting:

- The Chair is in charge.
- Public meetings law does NOT give attendees the right to speak.
- Don't squabble in public.
- Know the public meetings law.
- Keep accurate minutes.

- Ordinance = Local Law
 - Authority to enforce
 - Formal Adoption Process
- Resolution = Policy of the Board
 - Governs Internal Operations
 - Simple Adoption Process

Mission: Why the District exist. What services District provides.

Values: What our organization values.

- Understand Role and Responsibilities


Expectations of Manager (CEO)
